

## Annual Occupant Notification Form

Dear Parents, Teachers, Building Occupants, and Employee Organizations:

In 1986, Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) which required schools to be inspected to identify asbestos containing building materials (ACBM) located within their school buildings. Within the Buxton School, suspected ACBM were located, sampled (or assumed), and rated according to condition and potential hazard. The results of the inspection have been incorporated into an *Asbestos Management Plan*.

This plan includes periodic surveillance of these materials every six months and proper removal when any renovation is planned. As part of the *Asbestos Management Plan*, any identified materials are monitored and kept in good condition.

It is the intention of the Buxton School to comply with all federal and state regulations controlling asbestos and to take whatever steps are necessary to ensure building occupants a healthy and safe environment. The *Asbestos Management Plan* is available for review upon request, a copy of which is maintained in the school administrative office and in the maintenance office.
