¹ *The model we recommend is the Pentax K1000. A good price for a used Pentax K1000 is usually around \$150. Look for listings on Etsy or eBay that say "working" or "tested". Any functional 35mm film camera will work, including plastic point-and-shoots which are less of a commitment. Buying used cameras online is always a gamble, but it usually works out. There are places like B&H where you can buy new ones, but it's significantly more expensive. Students will also need a battery for whatever camera they bring. The Pentax K1000 takes an Energizer 357.
